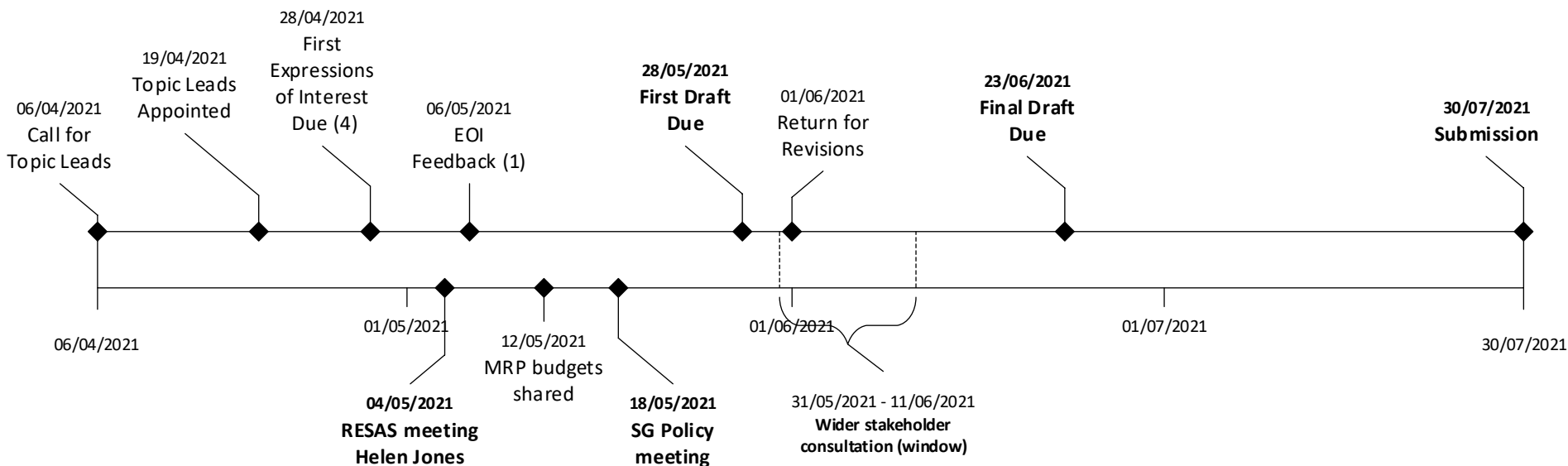

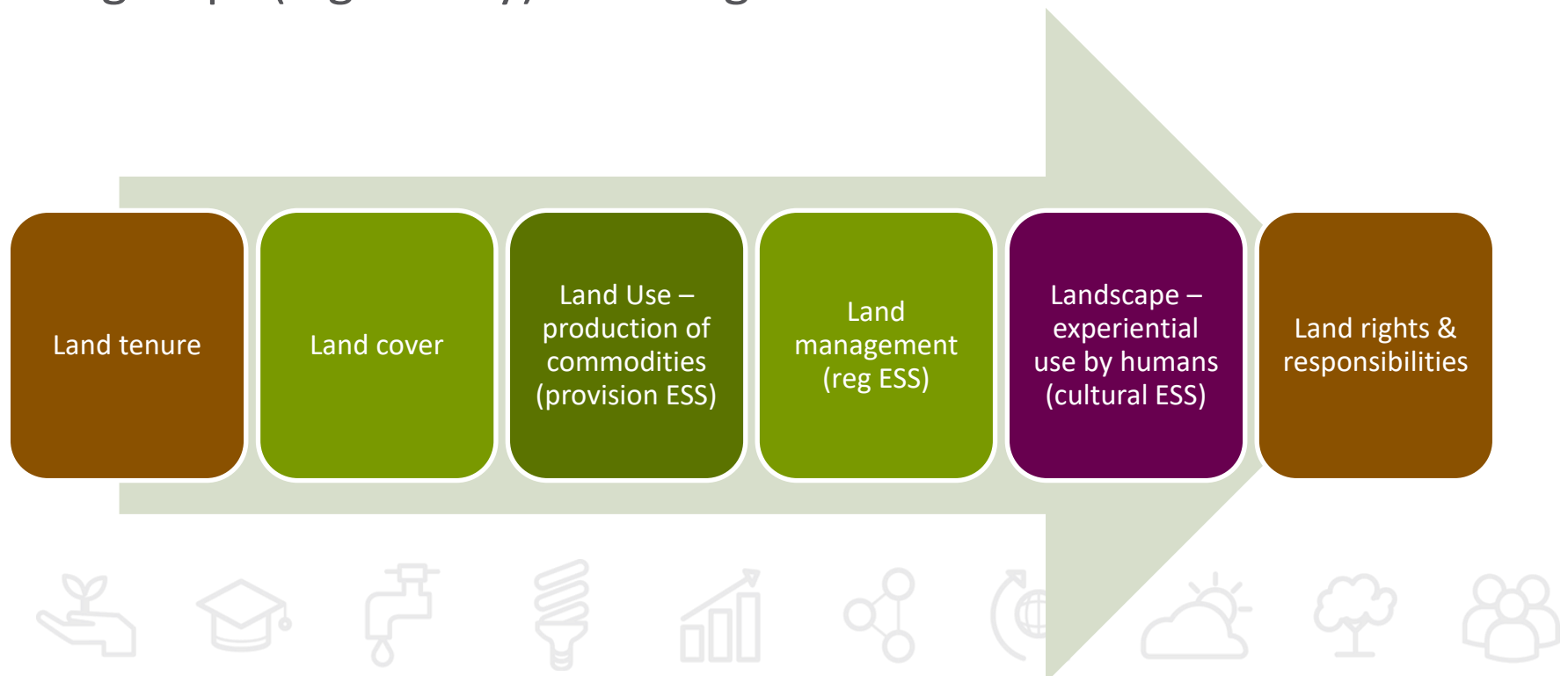
State-of-play & Process

- Also consider influence of 'public opinion' and pressure groups (legitimacy) - land rights

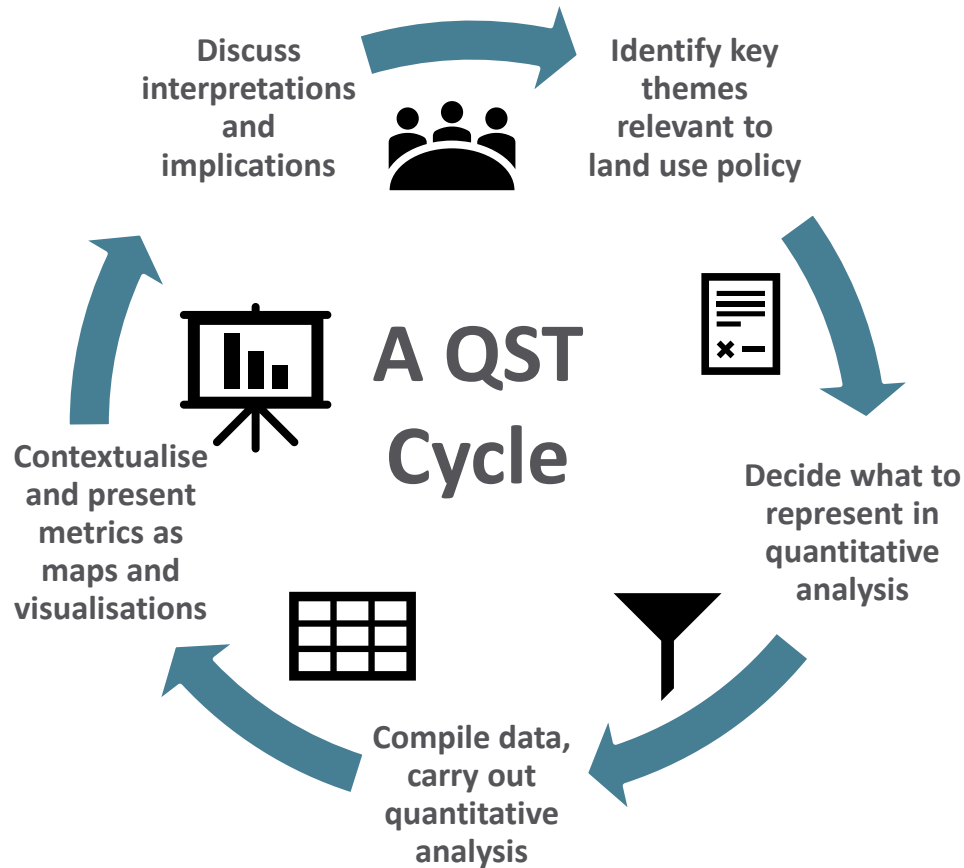

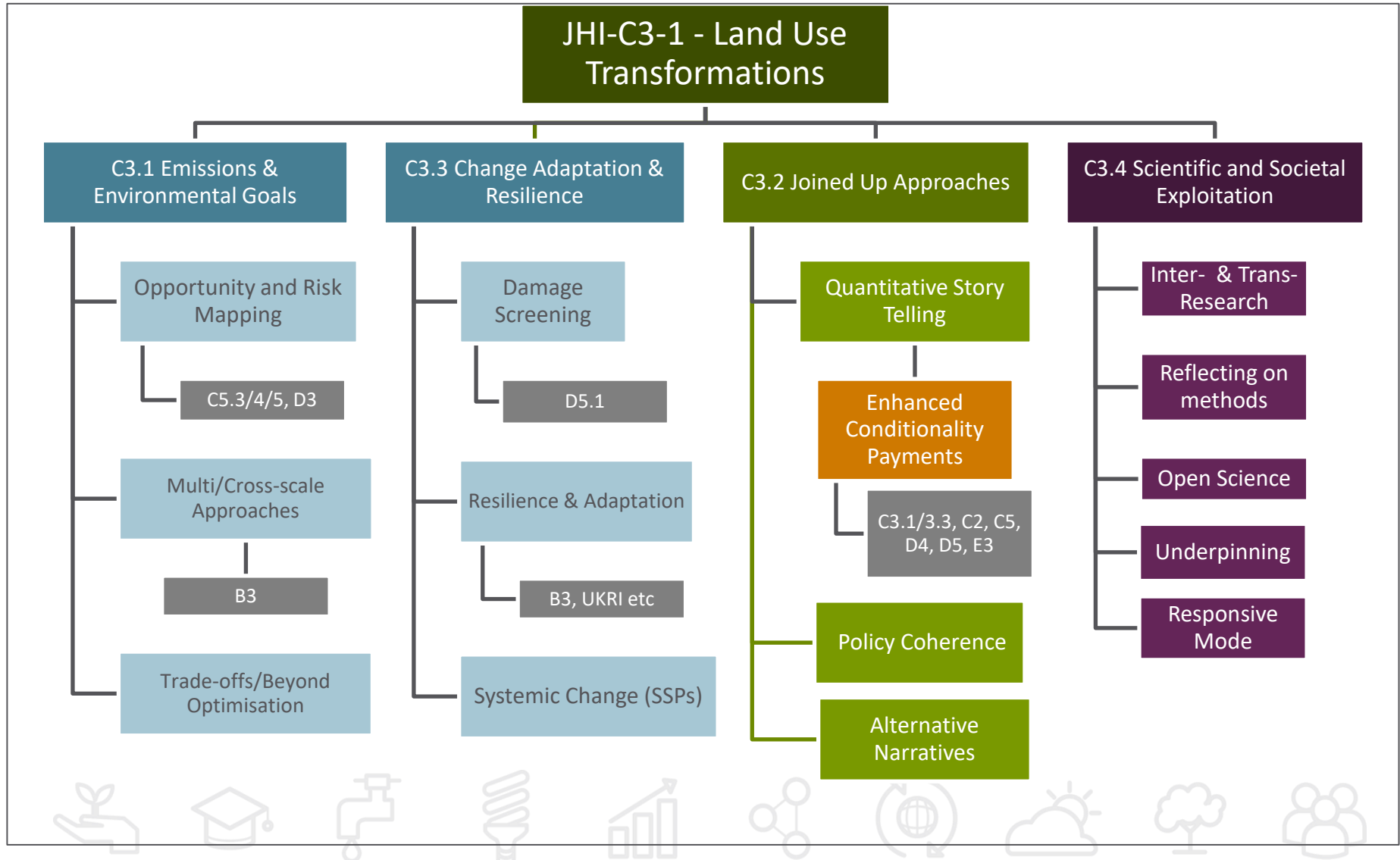
